Project Information: The sale of this three and one-half acre Archdiocese site in 2005 with its historically significant cathedral, convent, rectory and two schools opened an opportunity for the new owners to provide much needed housing, commercial and open space for the surrounding neighborhood.

Located on Centre Street at the core of the vibrant commercial district in Jamaica Plain, the redevelopment of this site engendered keen interest from community groups. Their input provided guidance for the programming of the buildings and the open space.

The goals of the landscape design are to preserve historic features such as the unique iron fencing, and specimen trees, and to increase public amenities.
